38th Annual Young Composers' Competition**

*All entrants must be NACUSA members. Music by non-members will not be considered.
Previous First Prize winners will not be eligible.*

All previous winners are listed on the NACUSA website address above.

1. The competition is open to all NACUSA members who are American citizens or Residents, who have reached their 18th birthday but have not yet reached their 32nd birthday by the submission deadline.
2. Compositions submitted should not exceed 12 – 13 minutes in length.
3. This year composers can submit works in the following categories: A. String quartet, B. Solo piano, C. 1-3 instruments with optional electronics/playback. If percussion is used, it should involve only one performer. No harp or celesta is permitted. Different categories will fluctuate over the course of future NACUSA competitions.
4. Compositions submitted must not be published and must not have won any other competitions. Each composer may submit up to two works.
5. Recordings (mp3 format) of the entire composition are highly recommended, but not mandatory.
6. Compositions will be judged, in part, on legibility and clearness of music score.
7. All scores **must** be submitted anonymously in PDF format, using the NACUSA website (see the guideline under Composition Contest). All mp3 files **must** also be submitted anonymously, using pseudonym only. Scores that do not adhere to the Contest rules will be **disqualified**.
8. The winners will be announced by April 1, 2017.
9. All prizes come with a possible performance on a NACUSA National concert. First Prize is \$400; Second Prize is \$300; Third Prize is \$200.
